

The COVID-19 Pandemic and Domestic Violence for City of Newcastle





One local refuge saw a 15% increase in clients over the 2020-21 period. Jenny's Place were unable to accommodate 575 women and 434 children due to a lack of funding, and were only able to house 12% of those needing a refuge. ⁽⁴⁾
